'*Prescientia*' is a combination of two words viz. '*Prescience*' and '*Scientia*'. '*Prescience*' is an English word meaning the fact of gaining knowledge in advance. '*Scientia*' meaning 'knowledge', is a Latin word from which the word 'Science' has been derived.

Dedicated and consistent efforts by the faculty as well as students of the institute gradually led this academic initiative to a successful one. Students of this coaching centre not only achieved their desired success in Higher Secondary finals but also cracked various prestigious competitive examinations and some got placed in reputed Engineering and Medical colleges of the nation.

Prescientia Coaching Centre:

Keeping in view of the necessity of a thorough, effective, modern and advanced education system in the secondary as well as senior secondary level at the heart of Hailakandi town, some young energetic academicians being inspired and motivated by some of their known well wishers suddenly decided to initiate a coaching institute viz. Prescientia Coaching Centre (PCC) in the year 2015. With a remarkably glorious inaugural function at Hailakandi Women's College Auditorium, presided over by the then Hon'ble Principal of Hailakandi Women's College, Prof Bijoy Kumar Dhar, PCC was inaugurated on 8th February, 2015 and practically initiated in a rented building at Shibbari Road, Hailakandi. After one year of financial struggling with very few nos of Higher Secondary students, PCC was shifted to Kalibari Road, Hailakandi in 2016 and after nine glorious years, in the year 2025, it was finally shifted to Tool Road, Hailakandi in the same building of Prescientia Senior Secondary School, Hailakandi. Along with regular long term and short term crash courses of H.S. & competitive exams PCC has been organizing various academic / social / cocurricular activities under Dibakar Trust of Tool

Prescientia Senior Secondary School:

After a long wait for 5 years of PCC's inception, the most awaited dream of establishment of a Senior Secondary School at the heart of Hailakandi, Assam came true. The Provisional Prior Permission letter from Department of Secondary Education (DSE), Assam to initiate the Senior Secondary School in the year 2020 was received on 19th March, 2020. Hence, amidst the pathetic situation of prolonged global lockdown due to COVID19 pandemic, *Prescientia Senior Secondary School* (PSSS) of Science & Commerce was established by Dibakar Trust at the same venue of PCC, i.e., Kalibari Road, Hailakandi. Arts stream was initiated in 2023 and in the year 2024 the school's temporary venue was shifted to Tool Road, Hailakandi. Till date, four Higher Secondary batches in Science & Commerce stream and one batch in Arts stream passed out from the school. The 1st academic session for secondary section (Class IX & X) was initiated in the year 2024.

- To ignite patriotic aspirations in the students' mind so that the students of the school dream to educate themselves for serving the nation with prestigious responsibilities.

- To explore, extract out and amplify not only the curricular academic talents but also the hidden special extracurricular capabilities of the students.
- To engineer the budding minds with positivity and help them move towards perfection.

School Uniform

Students must wear school uniform as specified by the school authority. If any student, improperly dressed, appears in the school during school hours, then he / she will not be allowed to enter the school premises under any circumstances. However, in this context, a penalty of Rs. 500/- may need to be paid in order to attend the school the other day. Moreover, possessing school bag (to be provided by school authority) daily during school hours and wearing navy blue coloured blazer / sweater during winter season (if winter wear is necessary) is also mandatory. If any student is found to damage the school uniform of other student/s during school hours, then the concerned guardian of the wrongdoer has to compensate for the same.

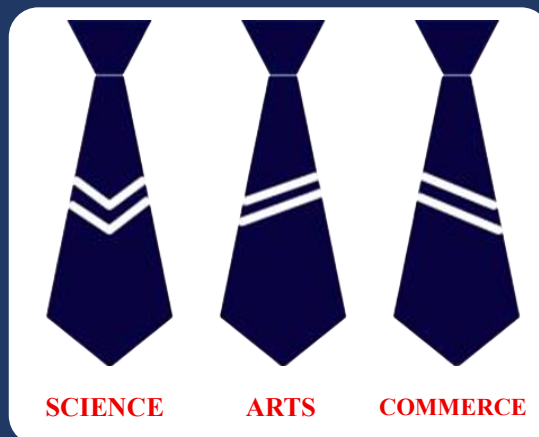

Attendance

A minimum of 75% annual attendance is mandatory to appear in the final board exam. Identity card scanning based - digital attendance of every student shall be recorded daily at the school's office room during school entry as well as exit of the student from the school campus. Attendance of students may also be recorded manually in the 1st / last period everyday. If a student's monthly attendance is found to be less than 75%, then he/she must pay a penalty of Rs. 1,000/- at the school office in order to attend classes in the next month. Submission of all assignments / practical note books / project reports within stipulated time and appearance in all the unit tests is mandatory

Identity Card

Digital school identity card shall be issued to all the admitted students which must be displayed in individuals while present inside the institute. Online application for receiving school identity card (with clear, recent & standard passport size photo of the student in school uniform) must be submitted during final admission. If any student loses the issued identity card, then it must be immediately reported to school office with a written application letter addressing the Principal.

Courses & Syllabus

Courses for Class IX, Class X, H.S. 1st year and H.S. 2nd year (Science, Arts & Commerce stream) shall be conducted in the school. Syllabus as approved and updated by Assam State School Education Board (ASSEB) Div - I (for Class IX & X) and ASSEB Div - II (for Class XI & XII) will be followed.

Eligibility & Seats

Students who have successfully passed HSLC / 10th Standard exam from SEBA / CBSE / ICSE board can apply for admission in the school in any stream. However, based on total no. of available seats in the school per stream (50 only), students will be s

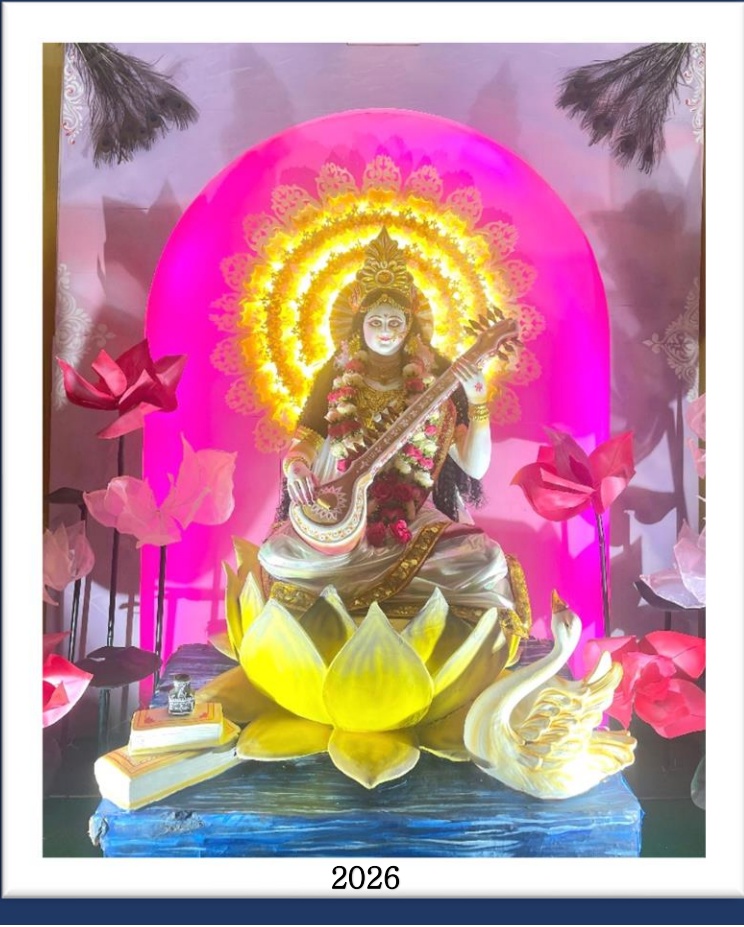

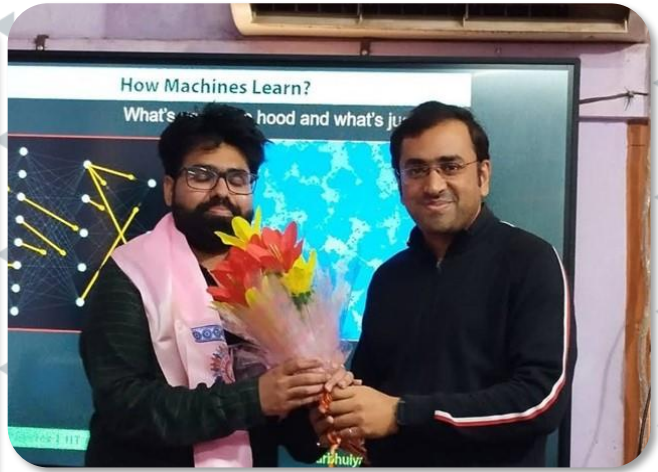

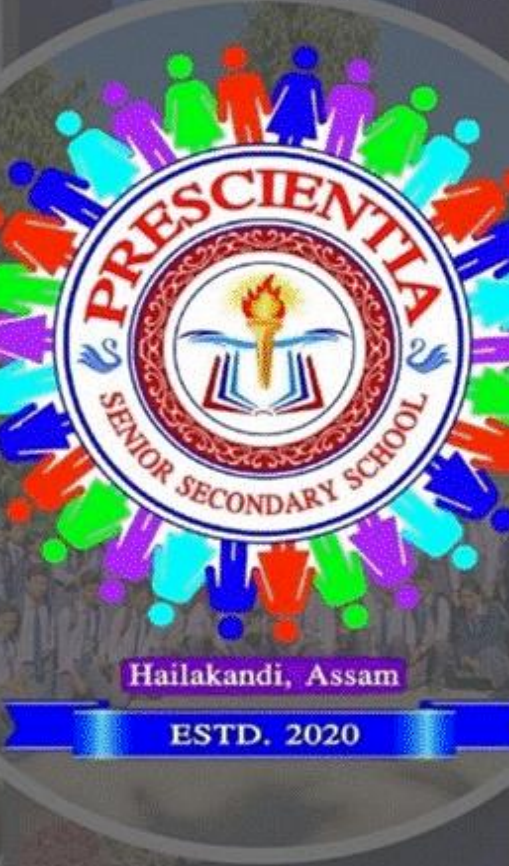
